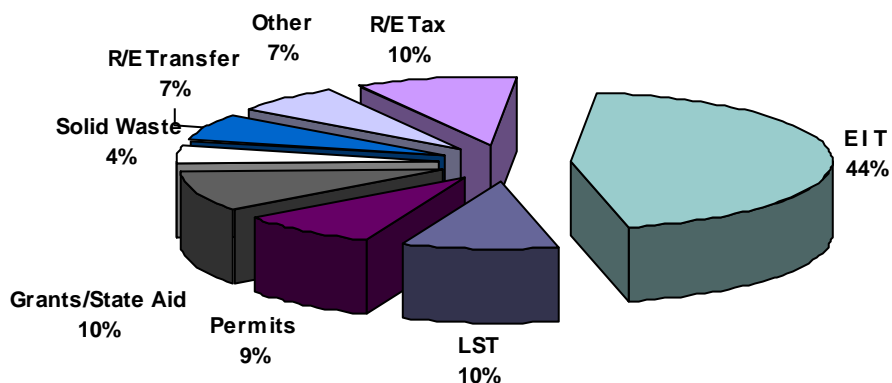


2008 Approved Township Budget

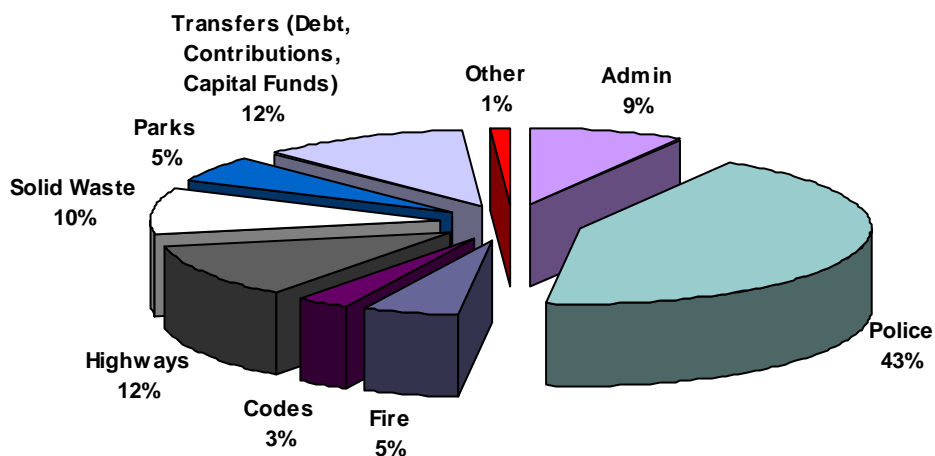
On December 18, 2007, the West Whiteland Township Board of Supervisors approved the 2008 Township Budget. In this balanced budget, the approved General Fund expenditures totaled \$10,277,595 and the Sewer Fund expenses totaled \$2,385,400.

The 2008 Budget includes no tax increases and no increases in sewer rental fees or trash bag fees. This accomplishment was made possible by the hard work of the Board of Supervisors and staff to effectively utilize available resources. This makes the sixteenth year with no increase in the real estate taxes which have remained at the current 0.6 mill rate since 1992.

As the pie chart below shows, the General Fund is mainly funded by tax revenues with earned income taxes providing 44% of the General Fund resources:



Below the General Fund expenditures are divided amongst the Township's departmental needs. As shown, the largest expenditures are found in the public safety areas:
